

Originally the seat of the kings of Munster, according to legend St. Patrick himself came here to convert King Aenghus to Christianity. Brian Boru was crowned High King at Cashel in 978 and made it his capital.

In 1101 the site was granted to the church and Cashel swiftly rose to prominence as one of the most significant centres of ecclesiastical power in the country.

The surviving buildings are remarkable. Cormac's Chapel, for example, contains the only surviving Romanesque frescoes in Ireland.

The Rock of Cashel is one of Ireland's most spectacular and – deservedly – most visited tourist attractions. Cashel Palace offers private access through our spectacular Gardens along The Bishop's Walk. You are then free to enjoy an audio tour or join one of the guided tours with a local expert on Ireland's Ancient East.



HORE ABBEY


Once a thriving Cistercian monastery founded in 1272, Hore Abbey now stands in peaceful ruin beneath the shadow of the Rock of Cashel. With its dramatic Gothic arches and sweeping views of the Tipperary countryside, it offers a striking glimpse into medieval monastic life.

The site is open to the public year-round, with free access via a small gate off the main road just outside Cashel town. There's no admission fee or tour guide, making it perfect for a quiet, self-guided visit.

HOLYCROSS ABBEY

Take a guided tour and hear the story of this incredible place from local guides, admire Cistercian art including the Sedilia and the Waking Bier and look out for Michael, said to be the oldest church bell in Ireland. Wander around the Padre Pio meditation garden, view the True Cross, share a secret at the whispering arch and see the only intact medieval chapter house doorway in Ireland.

Stop off in picturesque Holycross village with its cluster of thatched cottages and vibrant flowers. Get a sense of the history of this sacred place, a destination of pilgrimage for people all over the world, just a 15 minute drive from Cashel.





HISTORIC FAMILY HOMES

You will be warmly welcomed into these three landmark homes by the owners, complete with a guided tour and refreshments.

Castlegarde Castle

Whilst enjoying the scenery amidst the heart of the Golden Vale, you will tour 12th century Castlegarde, the oldest continually inhabited haunted castle in Ireland. With its 1820s extension architecture by the famed Pain brothers, watched by obscure stone effigies and haunted by the mysterious lady in silk, Castlegarde is just begging to be explored!


Grenane House

Grenane House is a breathtaking Georgian home set amid 300 acres where the family has resided since the early 17th century. Enjoy a stroll through Victorian walled gardens and feast your eyes on a children's play room that will make you feel as though you have turned the page into your very own storybook.

Lismacue House

With magnificent views of the Galtee Mountains, Lismacue House is a classically proportioned picturesque Georgian Home set amid a 200 acre estate. It has been family owned and occupied since 1704. Lismacue House boasts gorgeous and unique plasterwork with high ceilings and original wallpaper from 1813.

CAHIR CASTLE



Just a 20 minute drive from Cashel lies Cahir Castle and the Swiss Cottage. Built in the thirteenth century serving as the stronghold of the powerful Butler family. So effective was it's design that it was believed to be impregnable, but it finally fell to the earl of Essex in 1599 when heavy artillery was used against it for the first time.

An excellent audiovisual show now provides sightseers with a detailed appreciation of the castle's long history. Visitors also flock to the castle because of its role as a film and TV location – it has featured in productions like Excalibur and The Tudors.

In addition to the Castle, visitors can also enjoy a short walk to the nearby Swiss Cottage, a delightful ornamental cottage built in the early 1800s by Richard Butler, first Earl of Glengall. It remains an enduring local attraction in South Tipperary and an iconic image of the Ireland of yore.

SWISS COTTAGE

Tucked away along the banks of the River Suir, the Swiss Cottage in Cahir is a charming 19th-century ornamental cottage designed to enchant. Built in the cottage orné style, it once served as a peaceful retreat for the Butler family and remains beautifully preserved.

Access is by guided tour only, available daily from mid-March to early November.

Tickets can be purchased on arrival, with tours offered on a first-come, first-served basis. The cottage is a short riverside walk from Cahir Castle.

Every piece is skilfully crafted by hand using a potter's wheel. Their distinctive glazes are made from old recipes handed down from father to son.

THE HIGH KINGS LOOP

Starting at Cashel Palace, the High Kings Loop is a captivating 9 km (approximately 5.6 miles) trail that offers a relatively flat terrain with no significant elevation gain, making it accessible for hikers of varying skill levels. This loop trail is estimated to be of medium difficulty, providing a balanced mix of natural beauty and historical intrigue.

Wander through lush fields and woodlands teeming with native wildlife like red foxes, hares, kestrels, and barn owls, and follow tranquil streams along the way. At around 3 km, discover Hore Abbey, a 13th-century Cistercian monastery – a perfect spot to pause and explore. The trail continues through the breathtaking Golden Vale, framed by ancient stone walls and traditional farmhouses.

Navigation is easy with well-marked paths, but pack for changing weather and consider using HiiKER app for real-time guidance.

When you come to the end of the loop, you get to pass by and take in the breathtaking views of the Rock of Cashel, eventually making your way back to the Cashel Palace. A perfect blend of history, nature, and adventure. A personal guide can be arranged to accompany guests en route.

THE SUIR BLUEWAY

There is a 21km marked trail along the Suir Blueway river towpath from Carrick-on-Suir to Clonmel which is ideal for leisure cyclists and walkers of all abilities. The stretch between Cahir and Clonmel is mainly for water-users, except for the short 4km stretch between Cahir Castle and the Swiss Cottage.

Starting at the Gashouse Bridge in Clonmel, walk along the river until you reach Sir Thomas' Bridge, cross the bridge and leave the Blueway to follow the waymarked route of the East Munster Way into the foothills of the Comeragh Mountains until it rejoins the Blueway at Kilsheelan Bridge. Follow in the footsteps of merchants and tradesmen who made their living along this 17th century towpath. Take in beautiful bridges, castles and churches set in picturesque countryside – but keep your eyes peeled for wildlife such as otters and heron.



THE GLEN OF AHERLOW

The Coach Road Walk offers two loop options; The Classic Walk (7.4km) takes about two hours and starts at the Car Park at the top of Slievenamuck Hill while the Family Walk (3.3km) takes about 75 minutes and starts and finishes in the Upper Car Park.

The area is also rich in history, featuring sites like St. Berrihert's Kyle, an ecclesiastical enclosure containing ancient cross slabs and a holy well. Whether you are seeking adventure or serenity, the Glen of Aherlow offers a memorable experience amidst Tipperary's lush landscapes.


A notable landmark along this walking/hiking trail is the 'Christ the King' statue, erected in 1950, which overlooks the valley and serves as a popular viewpoint.

SAINT DECLAN'S WAY

Long before St. Patrick brought Christianity to Ireland, another figure walked quietly into legend — St. Declan of Ardmore. His journey from Cashel to the sea is today traced by St. Declan's Way, a sacred path and Ireland's longest pilgrimage path, winding through the heart of Ireland's Ancient East.

Connecting the iconic Rock of Cashel with the coastal village of Ardmore, this 115km Camino Trail passes through timeless farmland, ancient monastic ruins, sleepy villages, and the mystical Knockmealdown Mountains. Along the way, history lives and breathes — from holy wells and medieval churches to the stories still told by those who work the land.

Unlike modern trails, St. Declan's Way holds the quiet authenticity of a true pilgrim route, lovingly restored by local hands. It invites not just a walk, but a journey into Ireland's early faith, resilience, and spirit.

By journey's end, as the Atlantic opens before you in Ardmore, you will have followed more than a path — you will have stepped into a story that still shapes Ireland today.







GALTEE HONEY FARM EXPERIENCE

Step into the world of the Native Irish Black Honey Bee with Galtee Honey Farm – a family-run beekeeping haven established in 1970 by Micheál Mac Giolla Coda. Nestled in Glengarra Wood on the slopes of the Galtee Mountains, their hives span the picturesque Galtee Vee Valley across Cork, Limerick, and Tipperary.

Located just 20km from Cashel Palace, Micheál and his daughter Aoife continue a rich beekeeping tradition, producing award-winning honey, beeswax candles, and honey mead, all rooted in Irish biodiversity and heritage.


Cashel Farmhouse Cheesemakers is a 100% family owned and managed business. When Louis & Jane Grubb moved back to the family farm in the late 1970s, their ambition was to harness the quality of their sweet, creamy milk to make a traditional farmhouse product, and in doing so to provide a livelihood for their family and locality. From this notion Cashel Blue® was born and to this day continues to be made in a traditional manner by the second generation, Sarah and Sergio Furno.

Now enjoy a tasting experience like no other with one of the world's most famous cheesemakers. Visit their extensive farm and cheesemaking facilities in Fethard, just 20 minutes from Cashel Palace, you can book a Tasting Experience on any Tuesday, between 10am and 4pm (excluding public holidays). Welcoming groups of 2 up to 25 people, meet the family behind this incredible food story to learn about how Cashel Blue® rose to international success and enjoy a guided tasting session of some of their flagship products, which also includes Cashel Blue Organic, Crozier Blue (Ireland's only Sheep's milk blue cheese) and Shepard's Store, their hard sheep's milk cheese. BROOKFIELD FARM

Brookfield Farm is a family-run, sustainable farm in Nenagh, Tipperary, approximately a 60 minute drive from Cashel, dedicated to producing artisan products and unforgettable visitor experiences.

Guests will join Ailbhe in her workshop to discover the world of beekeeping, learn how to craft beeswax candles and taste the delicious honey fresh from Brookfield's hives. Then enjoy a leisurely farm walk through acres of flower meadows on the shores of Lough Derg accompanied by plenty of the farm's animals and wildlife.



THE APPLE FARM

The Traas family had been growing fruit in Holland since the 1800's, but moved to Ireland in the late 1960's because it was difficult to find new land there for fruit-growing, and so, Willem and Ali decided to make a move to Ireland. Because there was no structure to enable them to sell their fruit locally, they opened a shop at the farm in the early 1970's. It is the same barn that they use to this day to sell most of what they produce from 40 acres of fruit.

Join the Traas family for a tour of the farm to explore their sprawling acres of crops and to learn about their sustainable farming processes. There are also a number of seasonal experiences to enjoy, during the Summer you might just be able to pick fresh Strawberries during your travels or watch as the Traas family handcraft juices and ciders bound for Cashel Palace. The tour finishes with a tasting of a variety of produce made at The Apple Farm where inquisitive guests can also pick up some tips for growing their own crops of fruit and vegetables at home.

The tour is tailored to the interest of those coming, and the prevailing season (and weather on the day), focusing on horticultural and ecological aspects of what is grown and made from the produce.



TIPPERARY BOUTIQUE DISTILLERY



Jennifer Nickerson is one of the only female Whiskey Distillers and Poitin Producers in Ireland, whilst her husband Liam is the sixth generation of the Ahearn Family to grow and harvest Barley on the land. Jennifer and Liam are joined by Jennifer's Father Stuart Nickerson who is a Scottish 'Master of the Quaich' and a world renowned Whiskey Maker. The distillery itself is comprised of 4 copper stills (with the largest only 1,000 litres), a mash tun, 4 fermenters and hand bottling equipment. This is a true craft distillery dedicated to distilling their own homegrown barley to create both Irish Single Malt Whiskey and Irish Single Pot Still whiskey, together with white spirits such as gin.

During your stay at Cashel Palace, go beyond our incredible whiskey and spirit selection at our Cocktail Bar and visit Tipperary Boutique Distillery for a guided tour of their distillery to learn about the process of bringing spirits from grain to glass and enjoy a tasting alongside their master distillers.
